- * All submitted research must be original and not previously published.
- * The first name on the abstract, if selected, will be the presenter of the oral communication.

DEADLINE: June 30, 2011

AWARD:

An International Scientific Jury will select the top ten abstracts to be presented at the 17th SIN Congress to be held in Sorrento, Italy, 11 - 14 October 2011.

SIN will cover the costs of the travel, inscription fee, hotel and lunch for the presenters of those abstracts chosen.
